

## The Orinda Association's 2024 Fourth of July T-Shirt Design Official Contest Rules

I have read the OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES for The Orinda Association (OA) Fourth of July T-Shirt Design contest, and I agree to all the rules and regulations of the contest as outlined below:

- 1. The contest is open to all students currently enrolled in school in Lafayette, Moraga or Orinda, CA and are in grades K through 7<sup>th</sup>.
  - i. The Design must include the words: "Orinda", "4<sup>th</sup> or Fourth of July" and "2024". Only the colors red, white and blue can be incorporated in the design with the design intended for use on a blue t-shirt (the shade and color of the t-shirt will depend upon the winning design.) The final t-shirt color will be selected by and at the full discretion of The OA.
- 2. All entries must be original creations of the student contestant only. The creation must never have been published and must not contain trademarks, logos, or copyrighted works of any other person or business.
- 3. The Contest begins on March 25, 2024 and entries may be submitted until May 3, 2024 by 5:00 pm PST. See below for the locations of the Drop Boxes.
- 4. Only one entry per student is allowed.
- 5. The top winner and all honorable mentions will be chosen by OA and will be notified by May 12, 2024.
- 6. There is one (1) prize available. First (1<sup>st</sup>) prize: \$100 in cash, acknowledgment of the award in The Orinda News, acknowledgment on The Orinda Association website and a free Official Orinda 2024 4<sup>th</sup> of July T-shirt with your design on it.
- 7. The winning design will remain the property of The OA and will not be returned to you. The OA may use the winning design at any time after the contest. The winning designer may display their own design in a portfolio or personal collection but may not sell or reproduce the design for any other purpose once submitted to the contest.

## 8. FORM OF ENTRIES and LOCATION OF DROP BOXES FOR SUBMISSIONS:

- i. **WHAT:** Entry is to be submitted in hand drawn form on a paper 8.5" x 11". (No digital art accepted). *Student's name should be written on the reverse side of the art.*
- ii. <u>HOW:</u> Both pages of this form, which is an Entry Form/Acknowledgement and Assignment that the contestant has read and agrees to the rules must be filled out, signed, and affixed to the original art.
- iii. <u>WHERE:</u> Please submit the student art, attached to this form in the sealed drop-boxes located in the front office of: Sleepy Hollow, Glorietta, Wagner, Del Rey and OIS Schools. In addition, there will be drop boxes at The Orinda Association office at 26 Orinda Way, Library Plaza Level, and the Orinda Library Front Desk.
- 9. We reserve the right to pick one entry, more than one entry, or no entries as the winning entry.
- 10. The OA reserves the right to terminate this contest at any time, effective on the date of issuing the termination notice, and we are under no obligation to give notice prior to the date of termination.
- 11. You agree that if you submit an entry, you will sign an assignment and release form prepared by us acknowledging your acceptance and understanding of the complete contest rules including that the winning design is the property of The OA.
